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## IACT Becomes The Champion of 2015 Hactl International Forklift & Pallet Building Competition

The 2015 International Forklift and Pallet Building Competition was held on January 11th at Hong Kong International Airport's Super Terminal, where team IACT was the overall champion as well as 1st place winner in Pallet Building. This makes the second time in a row where IACT attained the top spot in the same category.

This year marks the 8th time Hactl (Hong Kong Air Cargo Terminal Limited) held the International Forklift and Pallet Building Competition, which also had the best turnout in its history. A total of 13 teams gathered from around the world to compete, which included major airlines such as Air France-KLM-Martinair Cargo and IAG Cargo.

In this competition, each team of 4 handlers is required to build a consignment of packages using a pallet measuring 64 by 125 inches. The score is based on two categories: forklift driving and pallet building. In each category the teams are judged by several factors such as the build quality of their pallet as well as overall safety during the procedure.

According to the general evaluation by the chief judge, "The skill level of all participants in this year's competition was very high, therefore the scores varied only by narrow margin." In regards to the build quality of team IACT, "even amongst them, the finished build of the winning team was impeccable", said the judge.

As a brand name in ground handling industry, IACT will continue the effort to provide safe and high quality service in export operation.
